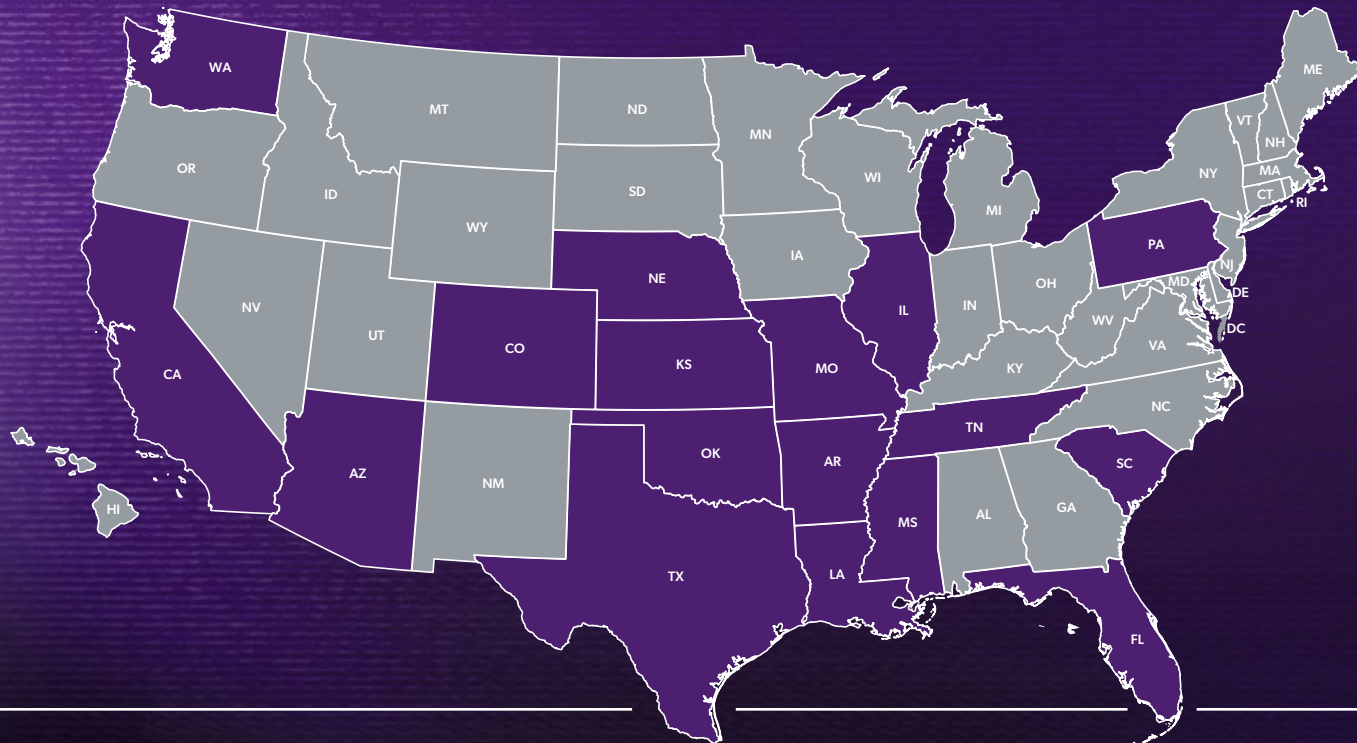

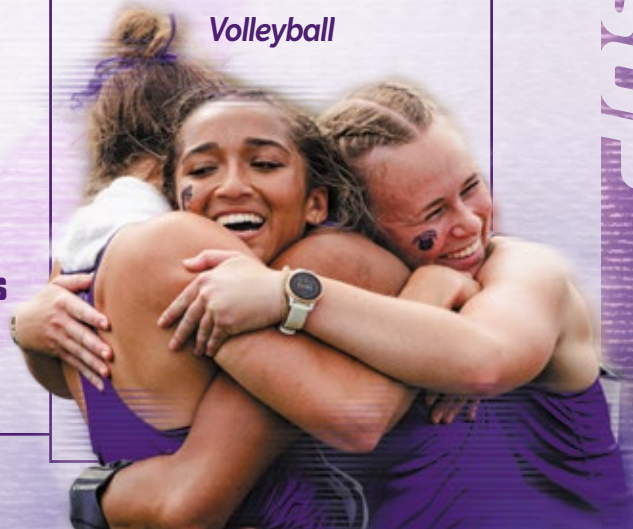

LETTERMEN'S CLUB

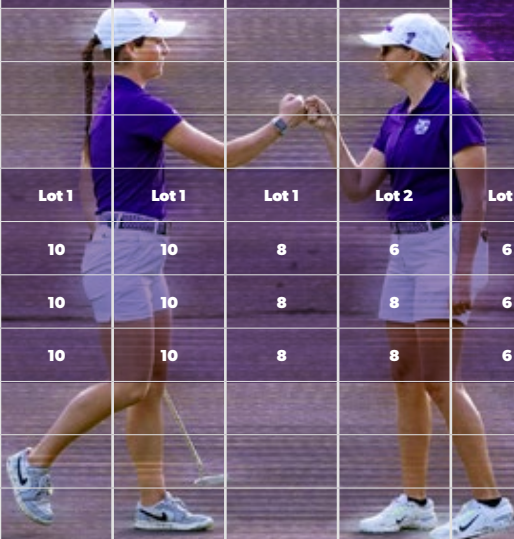
